Fund Manager's Comment

In August 2023, the MSCI Asia Pacific Islamic ex Japan Index (MIAPJ) experienced a significant decline of -6.30%. Every country within the index saw negative performance, with South Korea, Hong Kong, and Australia experiencing the most substantial decreases. On a sectoral level, all sectors contracted where most depreciation came from IT, primarily due to the surge in US Treasury yields and the strength of the US dollar, coupled with weak data from China. Noteworthy positive performers included Goodman Group, China Petroleum & Chemical Corp, and WuXi AppTec Co Ltd, emerging as top leaders, while Samsung Electronics Co Ltd, BHP Group Ltd, and Reliance Industries Ltd found themselves among the underperformers.

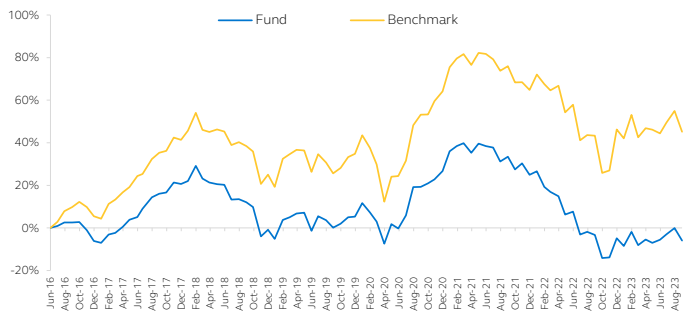

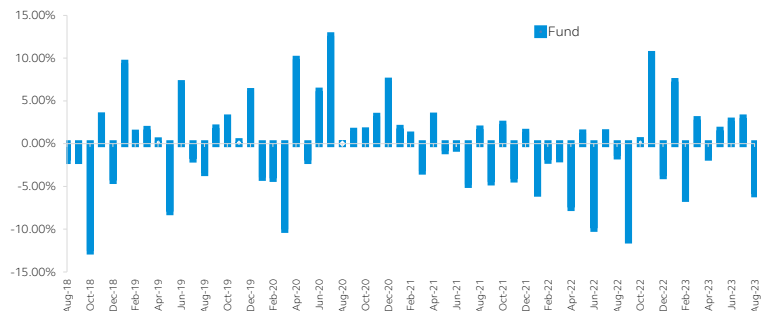
